Message from The Vice Principal

Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are in the best of health and enjoying the new year!

Attendance

I would like to thank those parents who have supported us in keeping their child's attendance to school very good, by sending your child(ren) into school or online, every day this week.

Understanding the relationship between attendance and student achievement is vital. Research shows that good attendance is essential to academic success. Chronic absence is described as missing 10 percent of the school year — or 18 days — for any reason, authorised or unauthorised. Children who are chronically absent in KG1 show lower levels of achievement in math and reading. That same research shows that children who continue on the path of chronic absence through to first grade are less likely to read confidently during their primary years at school. This then leads to achieving significantly lower grades compared to their peers who attended lessons every day. I am sure you will continue to join us on this journey ensuring ALL our students are attending ALI lessons every day.





Creative Curriculum

Even though we are quite restricted in having to remain in our bubbles within school, we have still managed to plan for interesting and stimulating experiences for the students to enjoy during Term 2. Our aim is to make learning creative and fun for the children. In addition, we have been finding out where our children are in terms of their learning so that this term we will be implementing further targeted support where it is needed.

Personal Social and Health Education

As a school, we have always placed huge importance on your child as an individual growing and learning within a community; our core values of respect, resilience and kindness echo this. This has not changed.




