The aim of the school is to have students dress with a school identity in a smart and presentable way, which conforms to standards of decency and safety and enables all pupils to be treated equally. The school uniform shows that pupils belong to our school community and should be worn with pride. **School Uniform & Student ID** is a requirement for being part of our school and is **compulsory** for all students.

Uniform policy for girls:

- Uniform: neck scarf and navy-blue leggings/black tights for those wearing skirts.
- Footwear: Black shoes only
- Head Scarf: White or light blue
- PE lessons: PE Kit (long trousers only)
- Accessories: Studs and a watch
- Hair: Ponytails or tied up without out hair falling on the face for safety reasons

Things not allowed:

- Makeup: such as mascara, eyeshadow, eyeliner, tinted eyebrows, lipstick or coloured gloss
- Nails: polish, long nails
- Shoes: high heels
- No unnatural hair colours (pink, green, blue)

Uniform policy for Boys:

- Footwear: Black shoes only
- PE lessons: PE Kit
- Accessories: watch only
- Hair: short and tidy
- Navy Blue jumper

Things not allowed:

- Ripped jeans
- Hoodies with logos
- Jeans
- Hats
- Outside coats are not to be worn in the classroom
